SETTING PRIORITIES FOR OUR FINANCES

- Give, Save, Live – what order are they in for you?

Identify what's most important currently in your schedule and what you WANT to be most important

1. How do you keep track of what you have to do?
2. How do you prioritize the events you say “yes” to?
3. What system do you use to keep track of your schedule and “to-do” list?
